Mr. Hiers is the Project Director, for Enterprise Services. In this capacity, he commands a Project Office responsible for acquiring, fielding, and performing lifecycle sustainment of technology and services supporting many of the Army Chief Information Officer's largest enterprise initiatives. He provides leadership to a staff of over 300 government and contractor personnel across three product offices.

His previous assignment was Product Director, Transportation Information Systems, where he commanded a product office responsible for the development, fielding, and lifecycle sustainment of multiple Army transportation information systems that provide 24/7 support to Soldiers responsible for movement of personnel and cargo during deployment and redeployment operations.

Prior to being promoted to the Product Director for Transportation Information Systems, he served as an Assistant Product Manager, responsible for the enterprise that hosted several Army transportation systems, to include its hardware, software, and other infrastructure components. He managed a master schedule of enterprise requirements/initiatives, oversaw budget execution, identified risks/mitigation strategies, and served as a Subject Matter Expert in several forums.

Prior to joining the Program Executive Office for Enterprise Information Systems, Mr. Hiers worked for the Army Chief Information Officer/G-6. He was responsible for developing Army IT policy and providing oversight of several Army programs, including the Army Land Mobile Radio and Installation Information Infrastructure Modernization Programs (I3MP). He also managed the Army process for identifying, prioritizing, and executing over \$600 million in Army IT requirements to support Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) 2005. Mr. Hiers began his Federal career when he was selected for the Army Knowledge Leaders Program, in which he successfully completed several high visibility projects within the Headquarters, Department of the Army Staff and two Army Commands.

Mr. Hiers received a BA in Computer Information Systems from Thomas More College in 2003. He received an MS in the Management of Information Technology from the University of Virginia McIntire School of Commerce in 2007. He is Level III certified by the Defense Acquisition University in Program Management and Information Technology. Mr. Hiers is a member of the Delta Epsilon Sigma National Scholastic Honor Society. He is a recipient of the 1105 Government Information Group 2009 Rising Star Award, the 2009 International Society of Logistics Enterprise Applications Award, and the Department of the Army Achievement Medal for Civilian Service.
