Mr. Steven W. Reichard assumed the role of Acting Product Manager (PM) of the Medical Communications for Combat Casualty Care (MC4) Product Management Office (PMO) on April 15, 2015. He also serves as MC4's Deputy Product Manager, a position he has held since December 2014. The MC4 PMO integrates, fields and provides technical support for the Army's deployable electronic medical record (EMR) system that enables lifelong EMRs for Soldiers from their service time through retirement.

Prior to serving in various leadership roles at MC4, Mr. Reichard held the positions of PM, Integrated Clinical Systems, U.S. Army Medical Materiel Agency (USAMMA); PM, Aeromedical Evacuation Mission Equipment Package, USAMMA; PM, Army Medical Commercial Systems, U.S. Army Medical Research and Materiel Command; PM, Medical Support Systems, U.S. Army Medical Materiel Development Activity (USAMMDA); DPM, Applied Medical Systems, USAMMDA; and Biomedical Engineer/PM, USAMMDA. In these roles, Mr. Reichard led acquisition life cycle strategy and harmonization, systems engineering, budget oversight and Army policy development.

Mr. Reichard's awards include recognized honorary member of the U.S. Army Medical Department Regiment, Commander's Award for Civilian Service, Superior Civilian Service Award, Order of Military Medical Merit and Service to America Award recipient.

Mr. Reichard holds an M.S. in National Resource Strategy from the National Defense University and an MBA from Frostburg State University. He earned a certificate from the Advanced Acquisition Program at the Naval Postgraduate School and a B.S. in Aerospace Engineering from Virginia Tech.
