WHO WE ARE

EBS-Convergence is a newly established program within PEO EIS's Army Data and Analytics Programs portfolio. EBS-Convergence is part of the Army's Enterprise Business System Multi-Functional Capabilities Team (EBS-MCFT), a coalition established to drive enterprise resource planning (ERP) readiness and modernization by 2030.

WHAT IS EBS-Convergence?

EBS-Convergence will provide sweeping improvements to Army business processes across the enterprise.

Specifically, it will:

- Implement a modernized approach to Army business processes through re-engineering
- Provide force element, equipping, readiness, and deployment capabilities
- Enable procurement, human resources, technology, logistics, and finance activities

The EBS-Convergence Product Office is charged with the creation of the acquisition strategy, as well as development and deployment of the Army's modernized/converged ERP system.



Once merged, the EBS-Convergence system will integrate with enduring systems, providing an all-inclusive view all the time.
