# A COLLECTION OF INTEGRATED DATA SERVICES, VISUALIZATIONS, AND ANALYTIC TOOLS

AESIP Hub is a system of systems designed to improve Army information readiness and data agility through the management of timely and pertinent data that facilitates fact-based and resource-enabled decision-making by Soldiers and decision-makers across the Army leadership spectrum.

## WHAT AESIP HUB DOES

AESIP Hub provides a centralized method for authoritative Army enterprise master data management. Our services, inclusive of Business Intelligence / Business Warehouse and other pertinent operational projects, increase efficiencies and evolve data capabilities by leveraging new and emerging Cloud technologies. The Hub also provides Enterprise Service Portal housing tools and applications and Identity Management (IDM) solutions via secured access enablers.
