WHO IS ATIS?

Army Training Information System (ATIS) acquires, deploys and maintains a worldwide distributed learning system to ensure our nation's Soldiers receive critical training. Unlike traditional methods of training that are costly, time consuming and require time away from family, ATIS program components provide Soldiers and Department of the Army civilians with numerous options to access Army training, creating a relevant and ready Army.

WHAT DOES ATIS DO?

ATIS delivers customer-focused, worldwide, adaptive Army training enterprise capability to the Total Force to enable training readiness anytime, anywhere.

ATIS PROGRAM COMPONENTS

- ATIS (Development) – ATIS will combine 28 legacy training systems into one, single solution that will provide training development, scheduling, resource learning & content management.
- Army Learning Management System – Centralized training management system that hosts courseware & delivers standardized training
- Range Facility Management Support System – Web-based range management application
- Digital Training Facility/Mobile Deployed/Deployed Digital Training Campus – Fixed, deployable & mobile classrooms used to conduct distributed learning training to improve individual & unit readiness
- Army e-Learning – Offers courses in IT, business leadership and professional development
- Enterprise Management Center – Technology & communications focal point for the program
