



GFEBS

The **General Fund Enterprise Business System** is a Web-based enterprise resource planning system that implements the Army's financial management system. GFEBS replaces or absorbs more than 80 legacy accounting and asset management systems to standardize business processes and transactional input across the Army.

GFEBS-SA

The General Fund Enterprise Business System - Sensitive Activities

is a fully functional GFEBS application operating on SIPRNet with additional security requirements to protect national security information. It enables the final retirement of legacy core financial systems, while integrating seamlessly with GFEBS to provide secure, web-based, realtime data to the Army's Sensitive Activities.



OVERVIEW

ArmylgnitED is the Army's enterprise voluntary education academic and credentialing portal that allows over 1.4M eligible Soldiers, Scholarship Cadets, and Army Civilians to request financial assistance for classroom, online learning courses and professional development anytime and from anywhere.

ArmylgnitED offers Tuition Assistance opportunities at over 2,500 colleges and university's offering over 300,000 college courses to choose from.

Tuition Assistance (TA) Program is a tailored program which funds eligible Soldiers' college courses.

Army Civilian education and professional development opportunities across all civilian functional communities.


